### Coaches Report:

We are quickly (if we have not already) developing a reputation as front runners. Our performance as a team was disgraceful, inept, insipid, weak and embarrassing. We were unaccountable, had our lowest tackle count (41) and our lowest SA total (70) for the year. A massive lift in intensity is needed from all players because only having 5 players out of 22 break even or win their position will not get us to where we want to go. The greater the reward the greater the effort required. We are not talented enough to win games of football without the 100% Effort. Wanting to be known as a RUTHLESS UNITED HARD team is great, however we need to act/behave/perform like that – we have to earn it, which will take a lot of hard work. Right now there is a question mark over whether we as a group are prepared to do the work. I really do not care if we win or lose tomorrow – I just want to see all 22 Karingal players giving absolutely everything they have got for 4 quarters - come off at the end of the game with nothing left in the tank – physically & mentally stuffed and then be able to look each other in the eye because they know that each and every one of them did everything they could for the team.
