Coaches Report

It was the battle for 6th spot with Chelsea overrunning us in the last qtr. Conditions were tough with a gale force wind favoring one end – the end that Chelsea were kicking with in that last quarter. We worked reasonably hard for most of the game; however we were slightly down on our Selfless Acts which is disappointing given the conditions and the fact that it was our last game for the season. The first half of the last quarter cost us in the end – Chelsea were able to win the ball out of the middle, run freely and put our backs under enormous pressure, constantly pumping the ball into their fwd 50. They were inaccurate in front of goal which meant we were still in the game right up until late in the last minutes of the game however the damage had been done earlier in that 4th qtr. The upside was the debut of young Jones, who looked right at home playing senior football. He was his usual determined, hard at the ball/man and was rewarded with a couple of goals and having a direct hand in a few others. His strong overhead marking was a feature of the game and I'm confident that he will do a solid pre season and be a regular senior player next year and beyond. There were a couple of passages of play where, Jones, Dixon, Kellerman, Bedford and Clements all were involved in a chain of possessions which should excite the Karingal faithful going forward. It is imperative that we a) keep and further develop these kids and b) we recruit some experienced senior players to help lead the way in order to make some serious advancement as a club on field.

From a coach/player point of view it is extremely disappointing not to playing in this year's finals series however I strongly believe that we're not too far from a top 3 finish given some of our performances this year.
