This week we were up against a very confident YCW side after their big win over Seaford in round one. Late start for the boys' on Saturday with the 1sts' playing Friday night, a great opportunity to play in front of a crowd!

Losing Ozzy, Sian & R. Quinn from last week, we were going to be a bit light on up fwd. But with 22 players on hand waiting for a game, I told the boys' who came into the side to take the opportunity when it comes. The first 10 minutes we were off to a great start, and I thought "Great! If the boys can keep this up we could be in with a real chance!" With YCW playing a very handy 2nds team & their best senior forward & best senior back playing, I knew it was going to be a game where we could not let the foot off the gas one bit! In the first half, we didn't put enough pressure on YCW which allowed them to dictate the game.

We will struggle to win games only laying 8 and 9 tackles a quarter when we should be laying 15-20 per quarter. Our team aim is 15 tackles per quarter, and if we can achieve this it will put a lot of pressure on our opposition therefore not allowing them to dictate the game and have easy inside 50m with someone on their tail.

BOYS we must have these 100% up every game for us to have every opportunity to win!!

We did possess the ball throughout most of the game but we over used it by doing too many hand balls. We had a good run in defence from Clarkey, Gonz & Banners but just kicked to stupid contest.

Not enough movements from our forwards made it hard to spot up targets!

We all need to start taking what we learn at training into the game e.g running in numbers, looking sideways from defence, leading to fat side up forward. We are doing this great at training, but we need to implement these into our games on a Saturday!

All players need to take any opportunity they are given, and if you are coming off the bench you must make an impact as soon as you come onto the ground!!
