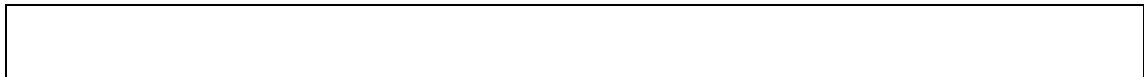

The other part of a nation's [money](#) supply consists of money deposited in banks (sometimes called deposit money), ownership of which can be transferred by means of [cheques](#) or other forms of money transfer such as credit and debit cards. Deposit money and currency are money in the sense that both are acceptable as a means of exchange, but money need not necessarily be currency.<sup>[1]</sup>

Historically, money in the form of currency has predominated.
