There has been lots of meetings and talk as this is the last year encompassed by the 2004 document governing local footy produced by the MPNFL. The review has now taken place as to the format and on going shape of the MPNFL from 2008 and on...

Structure Review

Langwarrin FC to play in Peninsula FL and Hastings FC to go to Nepean FL – the MPNFL believes this will enhance both competitions with more local derbies, less distance to travel for clubs, more even population spread across the 2 competitions, thus increasing rivalry and revenue for both clubs and competitions. This was done after reviewing the populations of competing clubs, club interviews and the best for long term local football.

Boys to Men Review

Removal of the Under 18s and introduction of Under 17s and Under 19s for each Peninsula / Casey Club – Nepean Will remain the same. Also the Senior Teams will be increased by 1 player to 22 to enable the advancement of an Under 19 player in the Seniors - 1 more point will be allowed in the PPS – taking it to a total of 39 Points. This is without doubt to encourage younger player development before playing senior football – and importantly retention of local youngsters. 4 games would be expected to be played all on the 1 ground in the 1 day commencing at 8.30 a.m.

Raging Bull understands the committee will be formulating KFC views on this shortly for the MPNFL Special Meeting on Aug 13.
