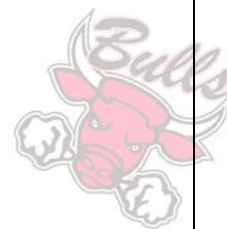

ANNUAL BALL 2008

Saturday 24 May (Round 6)

This year the MPNFL will celebrate its Centenary; 100 years of football (1908 – 2008). To commemorate this milestone, the MPNFL have released a calendar of Centenary Celebrations to run throughout the 2008 season, in what will become the largest sustained celebration of local sport and its history, undertaken in our region.

As part of these celebrations, Round 6 (Sat 24 May) has been named the Zaidee's Rainbow Foundation round. Established by Allan and Kim Turner in 2004, after the sudden passing of their 7 year-old daughter Zaidee, the foundation is dedicated to raising awareness and inspiring people to talk about organ and tissue donation. Originally from the Mornington Peninsula, the Turner family had been long-time registered organ and tissue donors when Zaidee passed away. In 2004, the year Zaidee passed, she was the only child in Victoria, under the age of 16, to be an organ and tissue donor.

Australia has one of the *lowest* rates of organ and tissue donation. Through initiatives such as Zaidee's Rainbow Foundation and the MPNFL's Round 6, we are aiming to raise organ and tissue donation awareness, and encourage you to talk about Zaidee's story with your loved ones. During Round 6, all players, umpires and supporters will be asked to wear Zaidee's Rainbow Shoelaces, as

part of the foundation's awareness campaign, and to show your support.

The Karingal FC Annual Ball, to be held the evening of Round 6, will continue with Zaidee's theme. Supported by the MPNFL, local media and Zaidee's Rainbow Foundation itself, this year's Annual Ball is guaranteed to be a very special event, one to remember. Mark your diaries, Sat 24 May at Frankston RSL.

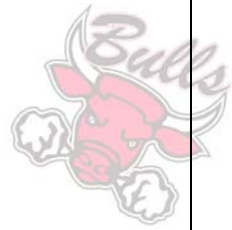
Each box is worth \$48 and you will have 3 weeks to sell them. Money and any remainder chocolates are to be returned to the club by 18th May 2008.

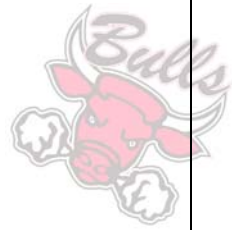

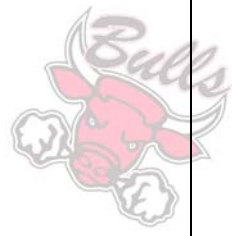
