Coaches Report:

Despite the bitter disappointment of the final result I was proud of the boys and their efforts to play the game out in atrocious conditions. It was a timely reminder / lesson for our young side that we must play every second of the game with 100% EFFORT because when you ease off on the pressure, good opposition sides take advantage. We had them in the gun at $\frac{3}{4}$ time however we were not desperate enough until it was too late. Each and every one of us must be Ruthless and have that Bulls Killer Instinct for every second and every contest of the game.

There were a number of times throughout the game where I felt that we were not switched on and I think we were

fortunate that YCW did not take full advantage as we may have been blown out of the park a lot earlier in the game. A lack of concentration, hardness around stoppages, poor tackling, not following instructions and poor accountability allowed the opposition to kick quick goals within those crucial first 7 minutes at the start of the last qtr. In the end those 7 minutes of the last quarter proved to be the difference with not only a 1 point loss being the result; now, instead of being at 4 wins 1 loss we are sitting with the pack at 3 and 2.
